**Questions and Answers:**

Q. How do the students parade around the parking lot?

A. The students will be announced by grade in the gym, and proceed to the parking lot **with their parents**

Q. How do I manage handing out treats at my vehicle as well as staying with my child as they trunk 'n treat through the parking lot?

A. The best way would be to have a helper.

Q. If I participate in the Trunk 'N Treat, can I decorate my trunk?

A. Yes, you can decorate your trunk as little or as much as you would like. All we ask is that you keep in mind the younger students. Decorations shouldn't be too scary please.

Q. How much treats do I need to get for the Trunk 'N Treat?

A. The quantity of the treats you offer is whatever you are comfortable bringing. However, we are asking parents to hand out one treat per child. (Estimate guess is around 200-250 pieces of candy- again please bring what you can).

Q. When my trunk is out of treats can I leave?

A. No. We ask that you please wait until the trunk 'n treat is over to avoid any accidents in the parking lot. (Estimate time around 8:30 pm).

Q. Can parents dress up?

A. Absolutely. However, we ask again that you keep the younger group of students in mind. We do ask that costumes are not too scary. No weapons please.

Q. My child's costume came with a plastic sword. Is it okay to bring it to the dance?

A. No. We ask that you keep all weapons (swords, guns, etc.) home.

Q. If we do not participate in the Trunk 'N Treat can we still attend the dance?

A. Yes you can still attend the dance. However, you will need to park your car on Dover Rd, Farmington Ave or in the synagogue lot across the street.

Q. Can my other children attend the dance if they *do not* go to STA?

A. Yes, siblings are allowed to attend the dance (remember 2 and under are free)

Q. Can I pay at the door?

A. Yes. Cash or check payable to St. Thomas the Apostle School only. Thank you.

Q. If I'm participating in Trunk 'N Treat where should I park?

A. Please proceed to the school parking lot and the attendant will assist you with parking. (You will not be able to leave the parking lot until Trunk 'N Treat is over (~8:30pm))

Q. When should I set-up my trunk?

A. You can set-up your trunk before, or during the dance. Decorate and have candy ready for the students by 7:45pm
